Spinach - Zisa F1

- Mid-green leaf
- Round to oval
- Main season maturity
- HR: Pe1-12, 14-16; IR: 17-19 EU*



Spinach - Freya F1

- Dark green leaf
- Semi-savoy appearance
- Medium-early maturity
- HR: Pe1-11, 13, 15, 16, 18 EU*



Chard - SCR144

- Intense red veins and petioles
- Good colour separation
- Vigorous OP variety

- Smooth, dark, burgundy leaves
- Narrow, oval shape
- Good processing qualities

Charisma

- Upright growth habit
- Good, strong, rocket taste
- Dark green, serrated leaves

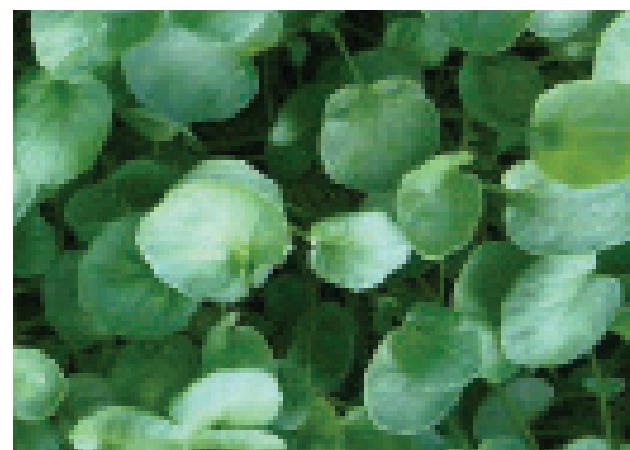


Red Sorrel - Fox

- Attractive green leaf with deep, red veins
- Well-defined, aromatic, citrus flavour
- More compact growth than Red Panda

Upland Cress

- Attractive, dark green, oval leaves
- Hot peppery flavour
- Dwarf plant with slender stalks



Coriander - Salsa

- Uniformly dark-green, aromatic foliage
- Good stem development for bunching
- Vigorous, high yielding and tolerant to bolting



Red Amaranth - Red Garnet

- Attractive fuchsia-pink leaves
- Mild flavour
- First true leaves are ideal for micro-mix salads



Parsley - Italian Plain Leaf

- Dark green foliage
- Good flavour
- Attractive appearance

- Dark red leaves with uniform colour penetration
- Mild flavour and good processability
- HR: BI 16-33EU, Nr:0*



Powerhouse

- Attractive, glossy, wine-red leaves
- Narrow shape, maintaining harvest flexibility
- HR: BI 16-21, 23-26, 28-33, 35, EU*
